<b>CONDITIONS</b>		
<b>The Applicant, together with its associated agents and subcontractors, acknowledge and agree to adhere to the following Conditions of this permit:</b>		<b>Initials of acceptance</b>
<b>1. Work Scheduling/Road Restrictions:</b> a. Stopping traffic on Route 1 is not permitted without prior written approval from the Province of NB. b. Lane closures greater than 5 days are not permitted c. Lane closures are not permitted, Monday thru Friday, as listed below: i. Westbound – Between Km marker 141 and Km marker 123 – 6am to 9am ii. Eastbound – Between Km marker 114 and Km marker 122 – 6am to 9am iii. Eastbound – Between Km marker 123 and Km marker 141 – 4pm to 6pm iv. Westbound – Between Km marker 122 and km marker 114 – 4pm to 6pm		
<b>2. Traffic Control:</b> Shall be carried out in strict accordance with the most recent version of the NB Work Area Traffic Control Manual (WATCM). The Applicant or designated subcontractor shall contact the appropriate Area Manager (listed below) <b>a minimum of 2 days in advance</b> of any traffic control.		
<b>3. General Laws and Regulations:</b> All work shall be carried out in accordance with the Laws and Regulations of Canada and the Province of NB.		
<b>4. Indemnify and Hold Harmless:</b> The Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Gateway Operations against any and all damage and or liability Gateway Operations may incur, however arising, through action or inaction, negligent or otherwise, including damage to property, personal injury and or death caused in any way contributed to by the Applicant, its employees, agents, subcontractor(s) or any others engaged by the Applicant.		
<b>5. Insurance:</b> The Applicant and its subcontractor(s) shall carry, per occurrence, a minimum Commercial General Liability insurance coverage of \$5M and a minimum Automobile insurance coverage of \$5M. Copies of certificates shall be made available to Gateway Operations upon request.		
<b>6. WorkSafe NB:</b> The Applicant and its subcontractor(s) shall be in good standing with WorkSafe NB (WSNB) at the time of the work and shall maintain WSNB Clearance Certificate(s) on site.		
<b>7. Safety:</b> Gateway Operations reserves the right to stop the work in situations where activities, events or incidents pose an environmental, health or safety risk		
<b>8. Work Site:</b> The Applicant shall, at its own expense, restore the work site to its pre-work condition to the satisfaction of Gateway Operations following completion of the work.		
<b>9. Additional Conditions:</b> a. No work shall proceed on the Route 1 Facility until this permit application is reviewed, approved and endorsed by Gateway Operations. b. Gateway Operations, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to revoke this permit and all associated approvals at any time and without notice. c. The Applicant agrees to maintain a copy of the approved permit on site, at all times, to be made available at the request of Gateway Operation or its Client. d. Additional terms and conditions may be added by Gateway Operations during review (see attached document upon receipt of approved permit, if applicable.)		
<b>ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE:</b> The Applicant and its subcontractor(s), agree to access the work site in strict accordance with the information and schedule submitted in the application and in accordance with all Conditions as outlined above.
